Signup online:

Once you have signed up you will receive an email with a show packet that includes the patterns for each class and submission details.

- Film you and your horse performing each class you select and upload the video to YouTube within the time allotted.
- You can then submit the link to your YouTube video via email to be judged. You'll be notified of placings once the show is concluded.
- You may opt to keep your video private so only the judge or IMHA staff can see it.

Filming and submission.

Film in an arena that is laid out with standard dressage letters. The camera should be held or mounted tight in the corner between A and K

- Once you begin the run you must film the entire run with no cuts or splices in the film.
- Film in landscape mode
- Avoid any zooming or panning. Try to keep the camera as still as possible.
- Sound must be turned on
- No backing track is permitted.

Post the video to YouTube.

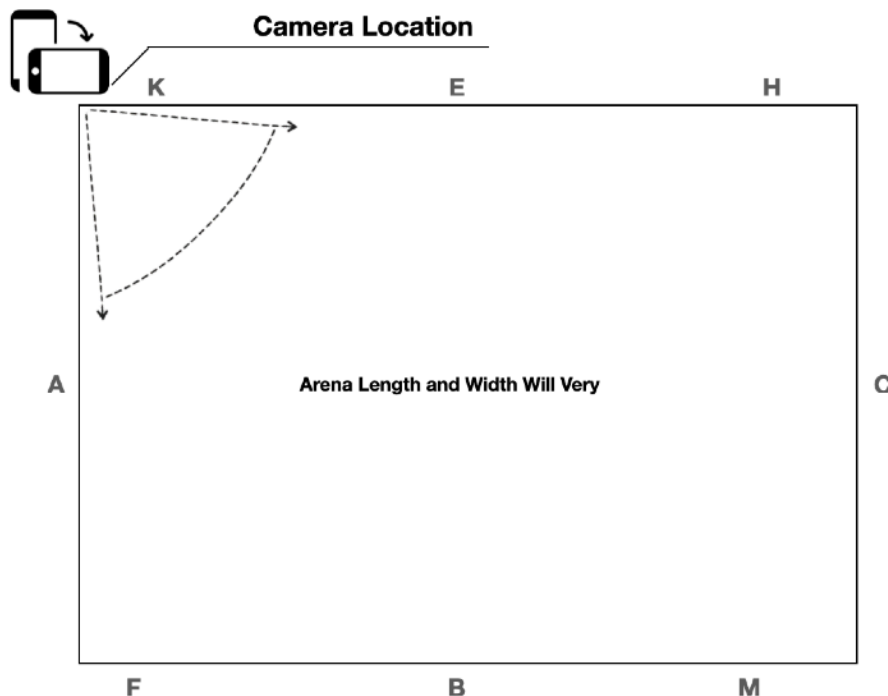
- You will need a valid google account. If you are unable to use YouTube we can accommodate other video hosting/streaming platforms as long as you can link to the video

Send the the link to the email provided in your show packet within the dates described.

Show Rules

- You must sign up to receive a show packet
- You must submit your videos within an allotted time (typically 1 week from the show start date)
- You may compete on multiple horses, but must sign up each horse individually.
- Horses and riders will both earn points according to the standard IMHA system described in our rule book.
- Only classes that you sign up for will be judged. If you decide to add classes you'll have to fill out an additional registration.
- There will be no refunds for scratched classes.
- Amateur riders may compete in professional classes however pros are not permitted to compete in amateur classes.
- Show packets must be kept confidential.
- Show packets contain Patterns and Show and submission instructions.
- **Riders who wish to compete in mounted or in - hand trail must have access to at least 10 ground rails and three barrels.**

IMHA Virtual Show Filming Guide



1. Insure arena letters (printable version in show packet) are laid out as shown and visible to the camera.
2. Camera should be positioned tight in the corner between K and A as shown
3. Camera may be mounted or fixed on a tripod or held by an assistant.
4. Shoot in landscape mode or with your phone turned on its side
5. Avoid panning zooming or any additional motion.
6. The class must be filmed in one take with no cuts or edits
7. Audio must be on and no backing tracks are allowed
8. Submit your video by uploading to your own YouTube account.
9. Submit each class as a standalone video with no additional titles credits or additional video other than the class.
10. Name your videos as follows :
your name / horse name / class number
11. If there's any additional info for the judge or others you can place it in the description of your video on YouTube.
12. You may submit multiple videos links in one email, however each class must be filmed and uploaded separate from the others
